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COMMON CARRIAGE v. CONTRACT CARRIAGE

OSRA 1998 Changes (amends the Shipping Act of 1984)

- Introduced Confidential Service Contracts
- Limited the scope of antitrust immunity
- Changed rate setting practice away from the conference system
- Created alternate tariff filing requirement with online availability
- Required USA OTI's to be licensed and bonded – others, foreign registered
- Effectively changed the system from Common Carriage to Contract Carriage

FMC Oversight of Tariffs & Other Rate Mechanisms

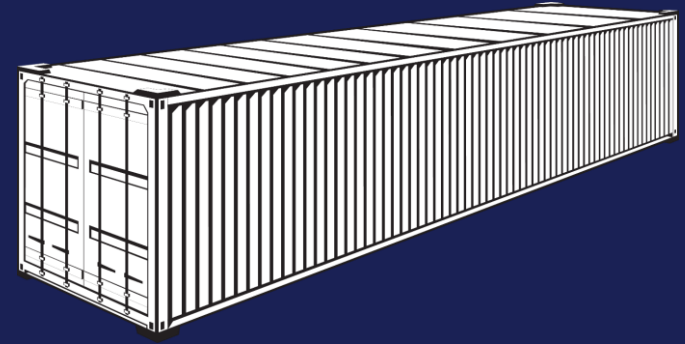
VOCCs (Ocean Common Carriers)

- post rate/rules tariffs for common carriage
- negotiate Service Contracts with BCOs or NVOCCs
 - File essential terms with FMC
 - 30-Day notice required for rate increase

NVOCCs – also sell to BCOs

- post rate/rules tariffs for common carriage
- May use NVOCC Service Arrangement (NSA) in lieu of tariff (30-day notice)
- May use Negotiated Rate Arrangement (NRA) in lieu of tariff (no 30-day notice)

FCL Rate Types



VOCCs sell:

Fixed Rates – subject to MQC & Penalty Clause

FAK or Spot Rates – based on market level / rate tariff

NVOCCs sell:

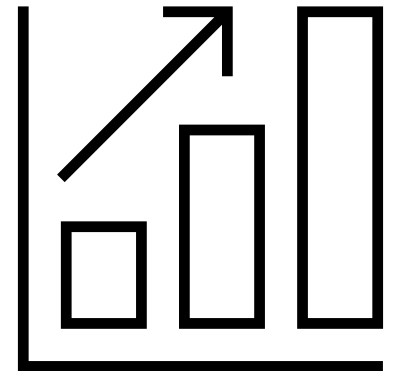
Named Account Rates – fixed or floating – NRA or NSA

FAK Rates – market level by tariff or NRA

When are Fixed Rates not Fixed?

Service Contracts Rates:

- Base Rates – Subject to Surcharges
- May point back to underlying Tariff
- GRI – General Rate Increase
- Limited by 'No New Surcharges' Clause
- Subject to Mutual Agreement
- Force Majeure
- Nuisance Surcharges



In a Perfect World...

Base Rate + Fuel = Freight Charge

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Base Rate + Fuel = Freight Charge

Most Common Surcharges added to Base Rates:

Fuel Surcharge (BAF, FAF, EFS, FRC, MFR, LSF, VLSFO, FS, FSC, EFF...)

PSS - Peak Season Surcharge

GRI - General Rate Increase

LCL Rating



Consolidated LCL cargo:

Rated by W/M - weight (m.tons) or measure (cbms) – whichever is greater*

- Light cargo is rated by \$\$\$ / Cubic Meter
- Dense cargo is rate by \$\$\$ / Metric Ton (1000 Kilos)

* Common conversion is 1 cubic meter charged for every 1000 Kilos.

Anatomy of a New Surcharge

- Houthi rebels attack merchant fleet in Red Sea (October)
- Ocean Carriers begin diversion around Africa (Nov/Dec)
- Increased cost to carriers is significant (adds 2000-4000 miles)
- Normally 30-Day notice required for new/increased rate
- Waiver Applications sent to FMC (end of December)
- Some lines declare Force Majeure

Anatomy of a New Surcharge

The Resulting Red Sea Diversion Charges...

CMA-CGM:	RS	Red Sea Charge
Hapag-Lloyd:	OCR	Operations Cost Recovery
HMM:	OCC	Operation Continuity Charge
Maersk:	TDS	Transit Disruption Surcharge
MSC:	CAC	Contingency Adjustment Charge
ONE:	RDS	Red Sea Diversion Surcharge
YML:	CR	Cost Recovery Charge

In Summary

- ✓ Fixed Rates are not always fixed.
- ✓ Look to tariffs as the source of surcharges.
- ✓ Nuisance charges are likely to appear.
- ✓ Terms & Acronyms lists are never exhaustive!
